It is our pleasure to announce that because of the continued generous support of the scholarship fund by the membership and Board, the New Jersey Asphalt Pavement Association is once again able to offer William J. Abbott Memorial Scholarships. These scholarships will be presented at our joint meeting with the NJSAT at the June 2010 dinner meeting.

These scholarships will be awarded to a dependent child or grandchild of an employee working for one of our member firms in good standing. The employee must have worked 1,000 hours during the prior year. Only students accepted or currently enrolled in a two or four-year college/university undergraduate or graduate program will be eligible. All undergraduate candidates must carry at least 12 credit hours for the current semester or nine credit hours for graduate level students. High school students must have been accepted to a college/university for the fall 2010 semester.

An application has been enclosed with this letter and must be returned to the Association by Friday, April 23, 2010. Completed applications must include: an official transcript, a signature from the employer confirming the employee's status, and a 350 word essay of your choice. Two letters of reference must also be attached; one of which should be from a school official. High school seniors need to include a copy of their college/university acceptance letter.
