
NJAPA and NJDOT Staff Meet

NJAPA staff periodically meets with NJDOT to discuss issues of importance to our members. These include meetings with design, construction, and maintenance management, and with each of those divisions. Recently, NJAPA staff met with Assistant Commissioner Lambert and the managers from project management, maintenance and operations, pavement and drainage management, and design to discuss the overall fiscal year 2018 outlook from a funding viewpoint and from a project type perspective.

A follow-up meeting with pavement and drainage management and materials personnel took place on February 6th. Topics that were discussed included pavement preservation for low volume roads, the 2018 outlook for the different pavement preservation techniques, expanding the use of RAP, increasing incentives for the use of high-RAP mixes, and tack coat.

NJDOT Fiscal Year 2018 Off to a Slow Start But Expecting a Strong Finish

While, Fiscal Year 2018 started off slower than previous years for NJDOT, but is poised to finish almost as strong as 2017. As of mid-February, NJDOT has awarded 28 projects worth \$300.5 million. These projects include 442,942 tons of asphalt. 11 more projects have been bid to date, totaling \$47.8 million.



In comparison, FY17 saw 39 projects awarded in the same time period, valued at \$392.4 million with 489,786 tons of asphalt.

Looking ahead, NJDOT has provided NJAPA with the anticipated projects, which include significant paving in both the capital program and the operations & maintenance program. 14 projects are currently advertised, including all 3 maintenance resurfacing projects for the 3 regions, each with 25,000 tons of asphalt. We expect NJDOT to keep to its commitment for a strong paving program in FY18.

NJ Legislature Advances Supplemental Appropriation for Transportation Funding

Legislation is moving rapidly in the NJ State House which would provide funding for \$166

for NJ Transit. The Bill has been approved by the full Assembly and will be considered by the NJ Senate soon. The bill is sponsored by a Bi-Partisan group of legislators in each house including member of leadership. NJDOT and the Governor's office have not spoken publicly about their position on the bill, though supplemental appropriations outside of the normal budget and capital program are quite unusual. We may learn more during Governor Murphy's first Budget Address which is scheduled for March 13, 2018. The bill which lists specific projects for funding is linked here for your review.

White House Infrastructure Plan

President Trump announced his long-anticipated infrastructure plan this past week. The plan focuses on 4 key points:

- Generate \$1.5 Trillion in Infrastructure Investments
- Streamline Environmental Permitting Process Down to 2 Years

- Advancements in Workforce Development and Training

NJDOT Gets New Overlay Tester

NJDOT has finally received a new PaveTest Overlay tester which has been on order for some time. The new equipment is installed, calibrated and NJDOT staff have received the appropriate training on the machine. The new PaveTest replaces a Troxler machine which had significant problems and which played a role in material testing delays. Kevin Monaco and Jim Purcell recently visited the NJDOT Materials Lab to get an introduction and demonstration of the new testing equipment.



The National Asphalt Pavement Association reorganized its committee structure in 2017 and has unveiled the focus of the future initiatives at its Annual Meeting, which took place from February 11th through 14th. The Pavement Economics Committee, which is where research projects are implemented, has been refocused to concentrate on Legislative, Life Cycle Cost Analysis, Life Cycle Assessment (environmental impacts), and Mixture Quality & Performance issues. A major focus of the committee is balanced mix design. Projects for 2018 will include:

- Lobbying Firm Services (Legislative Task Group)
- Urban Heat Island Effects (Life Cycle Assessment Task Group)
- Expansion of NAPA's Emerald Eco-Label (Life Cycle Assessment Task Group)
- Optimization of Asphalt Pavements for Improved Rolling Resistance (Life Cycle Analysis Task Group)
- PaveXpress Updates and Maintenance (Life Cycle Cost Analysis Task Group)
- Benefits of Rehabilitating Failing Concrete Pavements with Asphalt Overlays (Life Cycle Cost Analysis Task Group)
- Pavement Type Selection End of Life Considerations (Life Cycle Cost Analysis Task Group)
- Improving Asphalt Mixture Performance (Mixture Quality & Performance Task Group)
- Optimizing Bond Strength (Mixture Quality & Performance Task Group)
- Impacts of Polymer-modified Binders on Pavement Performance (Mixture Quality & Performance Task Group)

Other committees include the Committee on Asphalt Research and Technology, the Engineering Advisory Council, Sustainability, Environmental, Health and Safety, Political Action, and Legislative. At the Environmental Committee meeting, NJAPA Technical Director Jim Purcell provided a report on the latest developments for RAP in New Jersey.

NAPA Unveils Work Zone Safety Public Service Announcement



A new video, developed by NAPA, is the latest effort to drive this message home. This video follows the day in the life of a husband and father as he goes about his job on a paving project. A powerful and moving message to motorists that someone's future is in their hands.

Every year, more than 600 people die in work zone accidents and NAPA works tirelessly to provide tools to minimize these impacts on the lives of our workers and their families. One moment can save a life and the traveling public needs to pay attention to the road, especially when driving in a work zone.

PaveXpress No Includes an Instruction Module

PaveXpress, the online pavement design tool developed by NAPA through the Pavement Economics Committee, has been a huge success across the country and around the world. Used by engineers in various roles to design pavements based on AASHTO guidelines, it includes modules for new pavements, overlays, mechanistic design, and can be used to compare designs to PerRoad (the perpetual pavement design program). A new module, developed by the deployment team at the Asphalt Pavement Alliance, has been added to serve as an instructional guide to using PaveXpress. This tool, termed PaveInstruct, will not only provide guidance on how to use PaveXpress, but it can also be used to learn how to select the proper values for entering into a correct design and an understanding of the different structural components of pavement.

Look for the launch of PaveInstruct in the next few weeks.

FMCSA Grants NAPA Petition on Trucking HoS

On Jan. 26, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety
Administration (FMCSA) granted NAPA's request for
limited exemptions from the agency's Hours of Service
(HoS) regulations. The exemptions cover two HoS
provisions for drivers of trucking assets associated with
the "transportation of asphalt and related materials and



equipment," including dump trucks, equipment haulers, water trucks, distributor trucks, and similar equipment and vehicles. With the decision, drivers are now exempt from the required 30-minute break during their work day, and the maximum allowable on-duty time has been extended from 12 to 14 hours for drivers covered under the existing short-haul exceptions.

Although FMCSA did not provide an outright exemption from new electronic logging device (ELD) requirements, Record of Duty Status (RODS) is not required under the short-haul exception. Therefore, so long as drivers travel within a 100 air-mile radius from the location where they initiate on-duty service and return to the same location, there is no need for ELDs or RODS logging. Drivers must carry a copy of the exemption while driving and adhere to other FMCSA requirements identified in the document.

Earle and Tilcon Honored for Quality Construction at NJAPA Annual Meeting

NJAPA members, Earle Asphalt Company and Tilcon New York were both honored with Quality In Construction Awards at the NAPA Annual Meeting on February 14th. Earle's 2 projects, Route 29 in Mercer County and Route 202 in Hunterdon Counties, took awards for projects under 50,000 tons. Tilcon won an award for Wegman's in Hanover, also for projects under 50,000 tons.

In addition, Tilcon was honored with Diamond Achievement commendations for their plants in Mount Hope, North Bergen, Oxford, Pompton Lakes, and Riverdale. 4 of these have earned this distinction for 10 years or more.
