

#### NJDOT FY21 Paving Program

- Anticipated Awards July 2020 through June 2021:
  - 36 Projects
    - 8 Preservation
    - 28 Resurfacing/Rehab/Reconstruction
  - \$510 M Pavement Project Awards
    - \$45 M Preservation
    - \$465 M Resurfacing/Rehab/Recon



#### Balancing the Pavement Program

- Critical to Pavement Asset Management Strategy
- Preservation Cornerstone of Pavement Life Cycle Planning
  - Critical to Optimizing Network Performance
  - \$100 M Annual Recommended Investment



Preservation = Opportunity

- Preservation Program Maximizes Funding Opportunities
  - Reallocated funding
  - New funding
