NJDOT Project Letting Review & Forecast

For Fiscal Year 2023 which began on July 1, 2022 NJDOT plans to bid approximately 112 projects with a cumulative contract value of approximately \$1.1 Billion. This includes 38 paving specific jobs with a contract value of approximately \$280 Million. During FY2022 the department made improvements to 669 lane miles of roadway with a target of 790 miles for FY2023.

NJAPA Promotes Quality, Climate and Cost Benefits of Recycled Asphalt

NJAPA has successfully advocated for the introduction of legislation which would allow up to 35% recycled content in asphalt mixes used on projects governed by Local Public Contracts Law. The legislation is sponsored in the Assembly by the Chairman of the Natural Resources and Infrastructure Committee and the Chairman of the Transportation Committee. The Senate bill is sponsored by the Chairman of the Senate Transportation Committee and the Senate Minority Leader. NJAPA has expended significant time, energy, and resources on this important issue, and we are making major progress.

There is broad consensus that increasing recycled content will provide major environmental benefits as well as cost savings to taxpayers. While it has been generally established that quality roadways can be built with very high levels of recycled materials, NJAPA is working to demonstrate and further validate that fact with the engineering community.

New Jersey Turnpike Authority Hosts Productive Meeting with NJAPA Members

NJTA Executive Director John Keller welcomed representatives from NJAPA and thanked them for their work in addressing quality concerns raised several years ago. He advised that road conditions for the NJTA have improved dramatically since that cooperative effort. Mr. Keller expressed his desire that NJTA and NJAPA continue our partnership efforts.

NJTA Chief Engineer Mike Garofalo and members of the NJTA staff outlined the status of the NJTA Capital Program which is funded through 2027. NJTA plans to spend \$1 Billion annually through 2027. NJTA also plans 5 paving contracts for the current year with an overall contract value of \$100 million.

NJTA is largely satisfied with pavement performance following adjustments made by industry

several years ago. The Turnpike continues to utilize M mixes with L mixes on the Parkway. Warm Mix is used on all mixes on both roadways. The Authority is conducting research with Rutgers University regarding in-place temperatures to make sure they are gaining all potential benefits of warm-mix including reduction of off gassing to benefit workers. They also continue to review the concept and option of echelon paving. They are open to any suggestions from industry or individual contractors on ideas to eliminate joints.

The Buy America provisions included in the Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act is just one example of their engagement on a policy matter critical to our work.

Please note the recent update provided by NAPA:

NAPA joined with other groups to urge the U.S. DOT to issue guidance making clear that asphalt and concrete are statutorily exempt from the Buy America requirements included as part of the

Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act (IIJA). That letter can be found HERE.

NAPA met with the Assistant Secretary of Transportation last month and conveyed to him that the lack of guidance from the administration on this issue has caused confusion in many states and that they need to issue clear, cogent guidance so as not to disrupt the supply chain. That meeting resulted in the letter being sent into the Department of Transportation docket.
