
NJAPA Meets with NJDOT Assistant Commissioner Russo and Director of Local Aid & Economic Development Rankin

**Municipal Aid Grant Awards Discussed** 

The Executive Director and Technical Director of NJAPA met with NJDOT Assistant Commissioner Michael Russo and Director Laine Rankin to discuss the Local Aid Program, and, specifically, the Municipal Aid Grant Program. The purpose of the discussion was to learn about the local aid process in light of the increased funding levels and to determine where NJAPA can assist

municipalities and counties in delivering projects more efficiently.

NJDOT informed us that, for the most part, municipalities are obtaining the grants and awarding them in a timely fashion. With 95% of these grants being used for paving, it is important to NJAPA that municipalities and counties apply for the funds and use them for construction as quickly as possible. NJDOT showed us that approximately 60% of grants are awarded within the first year and 95% within the second year. Even with increased funding, this trend appears to be holding with the 64.29% of the 2017 grants awarded and about 30% of the 2018 grants awarded already. The following table and graph illustrate the past 4 years performance:



The NJDOT Municipal Aid Grant Program is funded with \$150 million (approximately) and, in Fiscal Year 2018, provided grants to 516 of the 565 municipalities in the state. The 2019 steering committee has met and announcements of grants will be made in the coming weeks.


### **NJDOT Update**

**Strong Awards and Asphalt Tonnage Numbers** 

NJDOT's Fiscal Year 2019 has continued with strong numbers. After setting records in the first 2 quarters for number of awards, award value, and asphalt tonnage, NJDOT continues to let and award projects at a greater pace than last year and, except for tons of asphalt, greater than 2017. As of the middle of February, NJDOT has awarded 59 projects with bid values of \$421.62 million,

and tonnage of 450 thousand. NJDOT continues to minimize the time to award. While all projects have averaged 26 days to award, those projects that are strictly paving have averaged 18.

As of the middle of February, the 450,000 tons of asphalt included in awarded projects is slightly more than the same period last year and about 40% less than the record year of 2017. Of the 20 projects already advertised for this quarter, there are 3 capital improvement projects with 147 thousand tons of asphalt and 2 maintenance roadway repair contracts with 93 thousand tons. Not yet advertised, but planned for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters are 7 Maintenance Roadway Repair contracts, and several capital projects with substantial paving worth up to \$209 million.



# **RAP Update**

NJDEP and NJAPA to Discuss Draft Guidance on February 21

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection provided the NJAPA with a draft of proposed guidance for the use of RAP on October 24<sup>th</sup>. NJAPA staff and K&L Gates, the Association's counsel, reviewed the proposed guidance and found it to be unacceptable, as it seeks to impose restrictions that were not intended by the law and, in many cases, are in direct conflict with the law. Much of the guidance is not backed by the science and is overly burdensome. Consequently, the NJAPA sent a letter to NJDEP outlining the objections to the guidance, indicating that further comments may be forthcoming, and requesting that the NJDEP and NJAPA continue to discuss this in meetings. ## **Tack Coat Handling and Sampling**

Postponed Seminar to be Included in Paving Conference Agenda

The NJAPA and the UTCA issued a construction advisory in September to remind contractors of the proper procedures for sampling of emulsified tack coat, and arranged for a seminar and demonstration that was scheduled to take place in November.

The seminar was unfortunately canceled due to inclement weather, but is being planned to occur during the 2019 New Jersey Paving Conference on March 19th at The College of New Jersey. The NJAPA has secured outside space for the hands-on demonstration of proper sampling techniques and arranged for tack coat distributor trucks to be on hand. Plan on being part of this demonstration on March 19<sup>th</sup>.

## **Pavement Mix Design Challenge**

**NE Regional Council of APA Kicks Off College Competition** 

The Northeast Regional Council of the Asphalt Pavement Alliance has kicked off the first regional pavement design competition for universities students. This competition is intended to encourage college students enrolled in engineering, materials, or construction management programs to learn more about asphalt pavements. Seven universities in the northeast region are competing – Rowan University, an NJAPA Associate Member, has fielded a team.

Teams will develop mix designs based on specific criteria, such as NMAS, RAP content, and binder type. They will also perform a structural design using this mix given specific loads. Pavement mixes will betested for rutting and fatigue and the teams will be judged on design, performance, and written and oral presentations. Winning teams will be recognized at the Northeast Asphalt User Producer Group meeting in October.

The universities are partnering with local asphalt producers so the students can gain real-world experience, working with practitioners in their labs. For further details on this initiative and how to get involved, contact Jim Purcell in the NJAPA office at (609) 838-1867.

NJAPA Staff Meeting with Municipal Engineers, County Engineers, and County Administrators to Discuss Local Aid Program

The NJAPA, responding to the call of its members and the Commissioner of NJDOT, has met and will continue to meet with the beneficiaries of the Local Aid Program to learn where the Association can assist in ensuring that funds are spent in an efficient and timely manner. Meetings have been held with township engineers, a county manager and public works manager, and the leadership of the New Jersey Society of Municipal Engineers, and are planned with additional county and municipal engineers over the next two months.

In gathering information on the stumbling blocks to awarding local aid grants, the NJAPA hopes to serve as a conduit between the NJDOT and the grant recipients to assist in streamlining the program. All parties that we have met with have welcomed this initiative.
