2023 was a productive and successful year for NJAPA. Our association was fully engaged on a range of legislative, regulatory, legal and technical matters on behalf of our members. The NJAPA Board of Directors has laid out a clear and meaningful agenda for 2024 which will continue to provide NJAPA members with significant benefits and return on their investment in the organization. NJDOT Bidding Outpaces FY2023

NJDOT has bid and awarded significantly more work during FY2024, which began on July 1, 2023 than they had at the same point in FY2023. For FY2024 NJDOT has awarded 50 projects with a contract value of \$670 million, compared to 35 projects with a value of \$187 million at the same time last year. At this point last year NJDOT had awarded approximately 90 thousand asphalt tons, to date for FY2024 they have awarded approximately 370 thousand asphalt tons.
