NJ Department of Transportation Announces Two New Baseline Document Changes

NJDOT has recently adopted two new Baseline Document Changes which impact the asphalt production industry.

BDC25S-02, is an update which will revise the air void requirements for High Performance Thin Overlays to improve resistance to rutting and blistering. NJDOT provided NJAPA an opportunity to review and comment on the change prior to adoption. NJAPA members will be working with the revisions this spring to provide additional feedback to the Department. The BDC is to be included in projects bid after June 15, 2025. BDC24S-26 requires a new materials approval process for Warm Mix Asphalt additives and processes. This action is being taken as the Northeast Asphalt User Producer Group has discontinued approval of these products effective January 1, 2025. The new review and approval process will be posted on the NJDOT website. The BDC is linked <u>HERE</u>.

William J. Abbott Scholarship Application

Due to the continual support of the Scholarship fund by the membership and Board, the NJAPA is proud to announce that we will once again be able to offer the William J. Abbott Memorial Scholarships to worthy candidates.

The scholarships will be awarded to a dependent child or grandchild of an employee working in the NJ Asphalt Pavement Industry. Only students accepted or currently enrolled in a two or fouryear college/university undergraduate or graduate program will be eligible. All undergraduate candidates must carry at least 12 credit hours for the current semester or nine credit hours for graduate level students. High school students must have been accepted to a college/university for the Fall 2025 semester. You can apply for a Scholarship every year.

Completed applications must include: an official transcript (no copies or facsimiles accepted), a signature from the employer confirming the employee's status, and a 350-word essay of your choice. Previously submitted essays will not be accepted. Two letters of reference must also be attached; one of which should be from a school official. New letters of recommendations will only be accepted. Previous letters of recommendations will not be considered. High school seniors need to include a copy of their college/university acceptance letter. Only correctly completed applications will be considered. Scholarship Applications must be emailed to Stacey Lindenmuth in the NJAPA office at staceyl@njapa.com. Please note they must be emailed by the end of the day on Friday, April 19, 2025. No late applications will be accepted.
